What is FSCM?

Conservationists need to be able to manage diverse groups of people with often conflicting viewpoints towards a shared goal. The FSCM course is designed to equip mid- to senior-level conservation professionals with key problem-solving and interpersonal skills, the skills necessary to manage conservation teams, stakeholder workshops and general meetings within their organisations.



The course will:

- Encourage you to reflect on your own learning style and the natural role you play in teams
- Develop your interpersonal skills, in particular your listening skills
- Introduce you to facilitation tools for surfacing new information and making group decisions
- Equip you with skills for conflict resolution and consensus-building

Where will the course be run?

The course will be run at the ITC based at the headquarters of the Durrell Wildlife Conservation Trust in Jersey (British Channel Islands). The Centre has trained over 1700 conservation professionals from more than 120 countries since it was established in the mid 1980s.

The ITC has a 54-seat lecture theatre, multiple break-out rooms, a dedicated conservation library and a networked computer lab. Participants will also have free access to Durrell's animal collection which is situated next to the ITC.

5 days (Monday to Friday)

How much will the course cost?

The total cost for the course is £1000. This includes six nights full-board accommodation on-site and the course tuition fee. Travel costs are the responsibility of each participant.
